

Amendment No. 4, published 31 July, 1967

to British Standard 2SP.7: 1943

Fork joints
(high tensile type)

Revision

NOTE. This amendment has been prepared to bring the standard into line with current requirements.

Clause 3. Anti-corrosion coating. Delete this clause and substitute the following:

3. Anti-corrosion treatment. All parts in non-corrosion resisting steel shall be uniformly coated with cadmium in accordance with the requirements of specification DTD 904*.

Add the following footnote to this clause:

*Ministry of Technology, Process Specification DTD 904 for cadmium plating.

Delete the words 'non-stainless' and substitute 'non-corrosion resisting' throughout as follows:

Clause 2. In lines 1 and 5.

Clause 6. In lines 1, 3 and 4 of the note.

Clause 9. In line 1.

Clause 12. In line 1.

Delete the word 'stainless' and substitute 'corrosion resisting' throughout as follows:

Clause 2. In line 2.
