REVISION.

Add note under title as follows:-

"The order must state the material classification letter and part number of the pins required, in accordance with Clause 6."

CLAUSE 6, MARKING. Paragraphs (b) and (c) to read:-

(b) " All pins 1/4 in. diameter (D) and over shall have the appropriate part number applied on or around the head and shall be marked on the head with the identification mark of the Inspector. If made of stainless steel they shall in addition be marked with the letter "Z" preceding the part number.

(c) All pins under 1/4 in. diameter shall be made into parcels which shall be labelled with the appropriate part number and also with the letter " Z" preceding the part number if the pins are made of stainless steel. Each parcel shall also be secured by a seal and stamped with the identification mark of the Inspector.

NOTE.- For ordering purposes a letter " Y" shall be inserted in the Part Reference Number for non-stainless pins between the Specification Number and Part Number so as to distinguish clearly between non-stainless and stainless parts.

For example, the complete Part Reference Number for a 7/16 in. diameter non-stainless steel pin of E length 0.80 in. is 4 SP.4 Y/K 12 and for stainless steel 4 SP. 4 Z/K 12, while the corresponding markings on the actual pins will be K 12 and Z/K 12."
